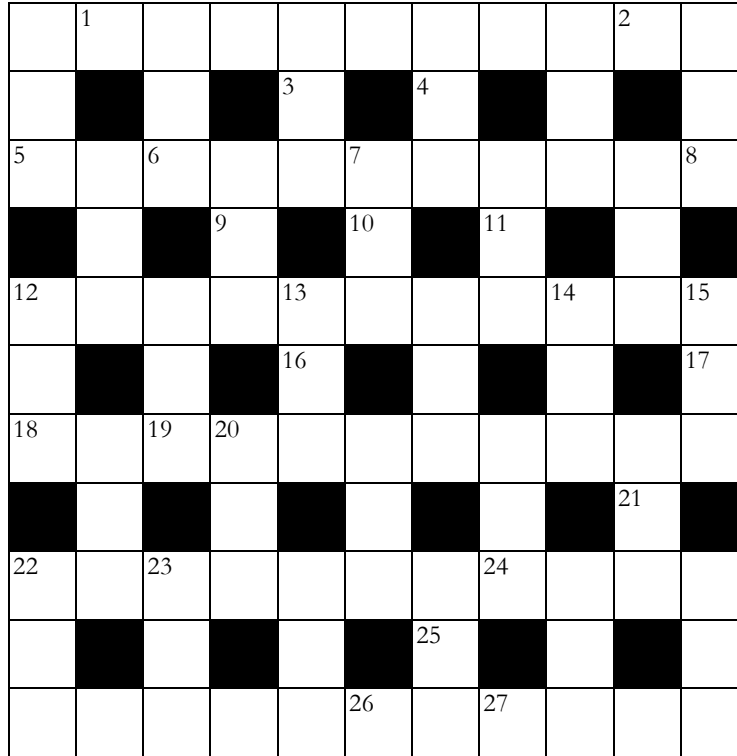


Pathfinder #6
